The Carnation Parade will begin promptly at 9:30 AM. Staging of entries will be from **35th Ave to 38th Ave on Ames St through Depew St beginning at 8:30 AM** and the only access to and from this area will be for Parade entries and homeowners. The Westernaires will be staging at Panorama Park so that area will be unavailable as well. **At 6:00 AM the City of Wheat Ridge will begin closing streets and preventing flow of traffic from 41st Ave to 35th Ave, Ames St to Upham St for the parade festivities.** We hope that you will grab a blanket or chair and join us along 38th Ave to enjoy our 53rd annual Carnation Parade! Please be patient with the closures as we celebrate Wheat Ridge with the longstanding tradition of the Carnation Parade. See you there!



Parade Parking!

Parking is available at various lots along the parade route. The most notable areas are the King Soopers lot at 38th Ave and Sheridan, the Chase Plaza on the northeast corner of 38th Ave and Chase St, the medical complex on Upham St, and at Stevens Elementary (large lot entrance on Upham St). There is also parking along neighborhood streets before the closures take place. Do NOT park in front of drive-ways or open businesses.
