

Wheat Ridge Pie & Cookie Contest

Event Schedule (Spaghetti Dinner Tent, Anderson Park):

- **Pie & Cookie Drop-off:** 1:30 PM – 2:50 PM
 - **Judging Begins:** 3:00 PM
 - **Winners Announced:** 4:00 PM
 - **Pie Slices & Cookies for Sale / Raffle Winners Announced:** 4:30 PM
 - Raffle winners can pick up their dessert at the spaghetti dinner tent.
 - Winners will be texted and all pies/cookies must be picked up that day.

Prizes (Adults & Kids Categories):

- **1st Place:** \$50, gift basket, 1st place ribbon
 - **2nd Place:** \$40, gift basket, 2nd place ribbon
 - **3rd Place:** \$20, gift basket, 3rd place ribbon

Entry Fee: \$10 per pie or dozen cookies

- Categories: **Adults & Kids**
 - **Theme:** “*What is Wheat Ridge?*”
 - Tell a story of how your sweet treat represents Wheat Ridge. Please print your story when dropping off.

Pie Rules:

1. Open to all ages (choose Adult or Kids category)
2. Pies must be 8-10" round, on a disposable plate/pan with a cover
3. Must be handmade by the contestant
4. Each contestant can enter up to 3 pies
5. **No cream pies** (no refrigeration available)
6. Include: baker's name, pie name, recipe, and story
7. Bring a **duplicate of the same pie** for the raffle (\$10 entry fee will be reimbursed)

Cookie Rules:

1. Open to all ages (choose Adult or Kids category)
2. Submit 1 dozen cookies in a disposable container with a lid
3. Must be homemade by the contestant
4. Each contestant can enter up to 3 dozen cookies

5. Include: baker's name, cookie name, recipe, and story
 6. Bring a **duplicate of the same dozen** for the raffle (entry fee will be reimbursed)

How to Enter:

- **Register in advance:** bit.ly/2022WRPieContestEntry
- On **Saturday, August 9th**, between 1:30 PM and 2:50 PM, bring your pie or cookies to the contest booth in the large tent at Anderson Park (near the Spaghetti Dinner area).
- Complete the registration form and acknowledge that your entry becomes property of the Wheat Ridge Carnation Festival and will not be returned.
- Provide your recipe and story on an index card or paper.
- Pies and cookies will be judged anonymously, with each assigned a number. The judging area is restricted to judges and volunteers.
- **Judging Criteria:**
 - Overall appearance
 - Consistency
 - Taste
 - Story of "*What Makes This Wheat Ridge?*"

In case of a tie, judges will decide the winner. Judges' decisions are final.

After the Contest:

- Pie slices and cookies will be sold for **\$5 each**.
- Raffle tickets: **\$5 each**.
- All proceeds benefit **PorchLight**, a family justice center supporting victims of violence.
